**6.04.010 Leash law.**

It is unlawful for the owner or custodian of any dog to cause, permit, or allow such dog to roam, run, stray, or to be away from the premises of such owner or custodian and to be on any public place, or on any public property, or the private property of another in Pacific County, unless such dog while away from such premises is controlled by a leash or chain not more than eight feet in length, such control to be exercised by such owner or custodian or other competent and authorized person; and any dog found roaming, running, straying or being away from such premises and not on leash as herein provided may be destroyed by the sheriff of Pacific County. **6.04.020 Violation – Penalty.**

Anyone violating or failing to comply with the provisions of PCC 6.04.010 shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50.00, or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding 10 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. [Ord. 36 § 2, 1970]

STOCK RESTRICTED AREAS<sup>1</sup>

**6.08.010 Areas designated.**

All areas of unincorporated Pacific County are declared stock restricted areas. [Order dated 8/25/92]

**6.08.020 Violation – Misdemeanor.**

Any person, or any agent, employee or representative of a corporation, violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor pursuant to RCW 16.24.040. [Order dated 8/25/92]

1. State law reference: Ch. 16.24 RCW – The county legislative authority of any county of this state shall have the power to designate by an order made and published certain territory as stock restricted area within such county in which it shall be unlawful to permit livestock of any kind to run at large.
