The mix of habitats allow for more than 200 bird species to rest, nest and winter. Enjoy the Art Walk Trail and keep an eye out for chum salmon, Roosevelt elk and over a dozen species of amphibians. Launch a kayak, canoe or boat and venture to Long Island.
